

Psychosocial residential rehabilitation

Williamstown



Mind's support model

This service provides people who have significant mental health and wellbeing concerns with accommodation and a rehabilitation focused program for up to two years to help them build their capacity to live independently.

24/7 NDIS funded support is provided onsite from Mind staff who will help you with daily life tasks and develop your skills for independent living, including helping you to connect with activities and other supports in the community.

About the residence

Located in Williamstown - a south-west suburb of Melbourne - this property is walking distance from local shops, cafes and the beach. The residence has a large courtyard with outdoor seating, veggie garden and BBQ area. The staff base is located within the premises but is separate from the residential living quarters. All residents sign a Residential Tenancy Agreement with a registered Community Housing Agency.

Tenancy information

Tenancy is managed by The Haven Foundation who will establish the rental agreement with you and the other tenants. Mind will manage the maintenance of the property.

Rent is set at 25% of your Disability Support Payment plus Commonwealth Rent Assistance. Utilities are billed separately.



Applications are now open

We are seeking applications from people who have a psychosocial disability and have been assessed as eligible for an NDIS package with an appropriate level of Supported Independent Living or Core supports that fund assistance with daily living.
